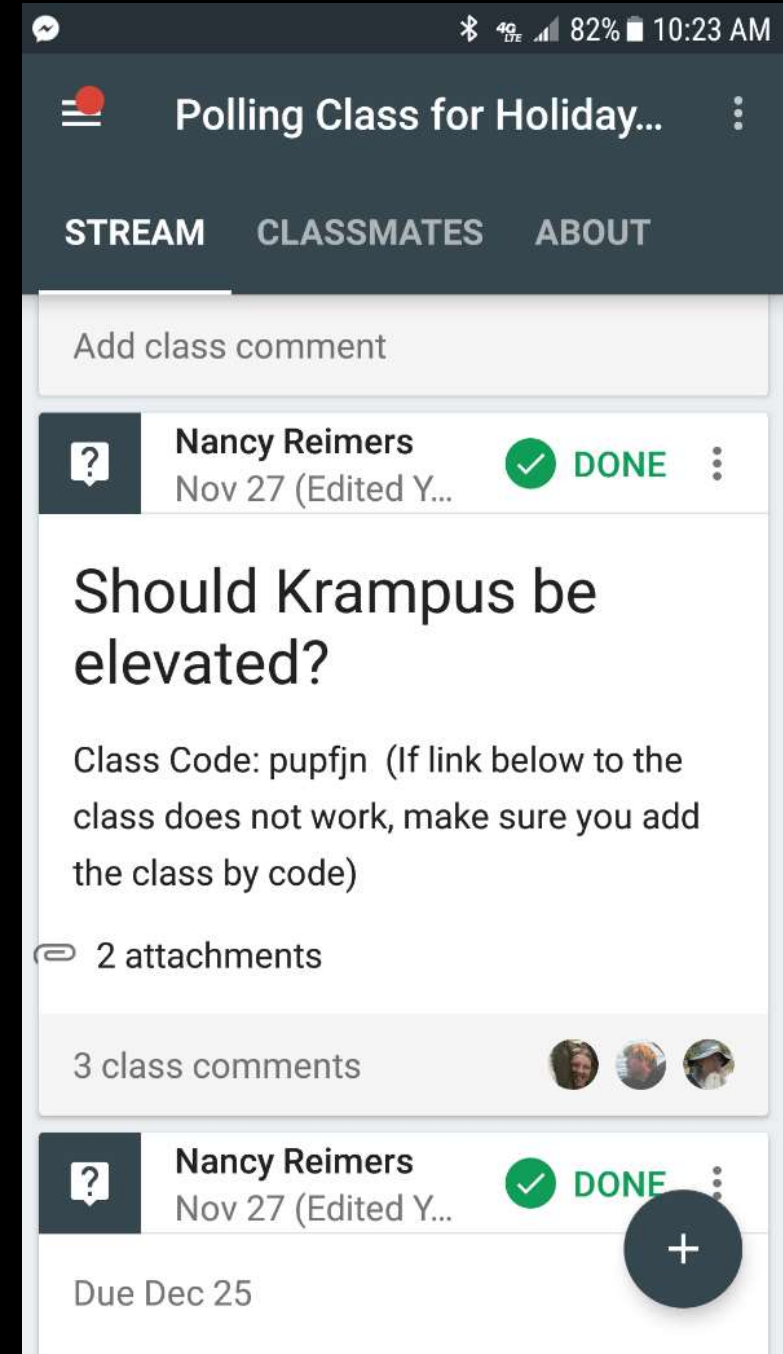


Polling Basics

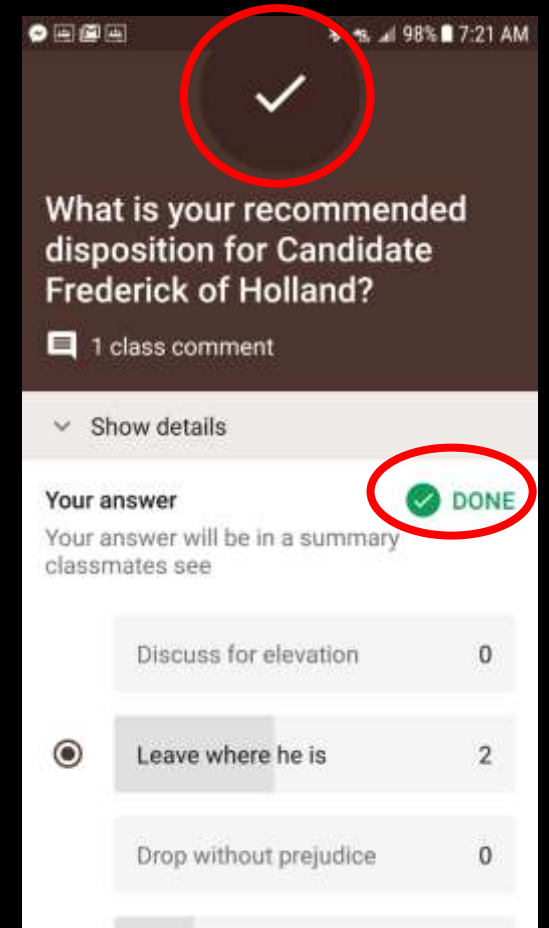
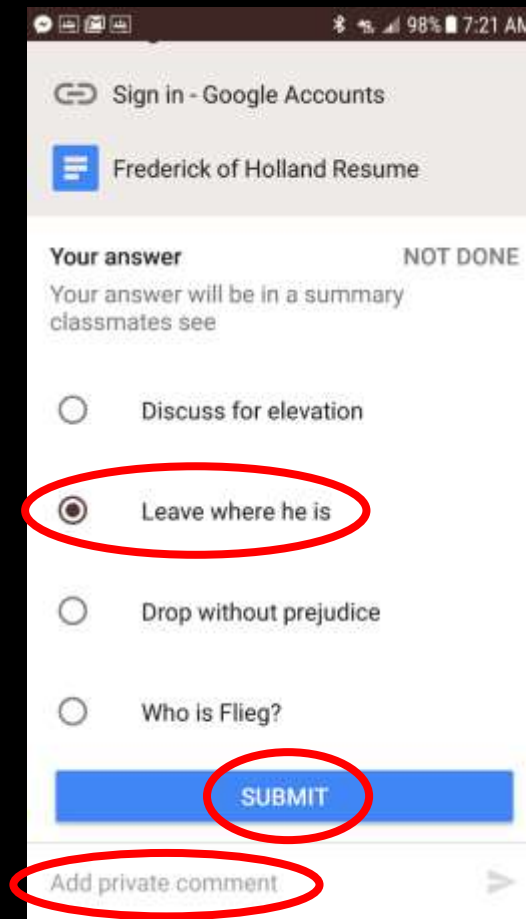
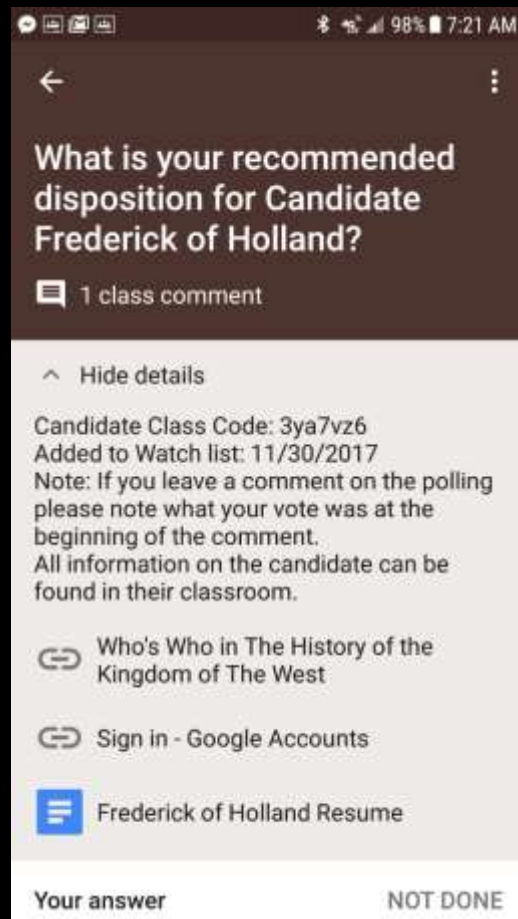
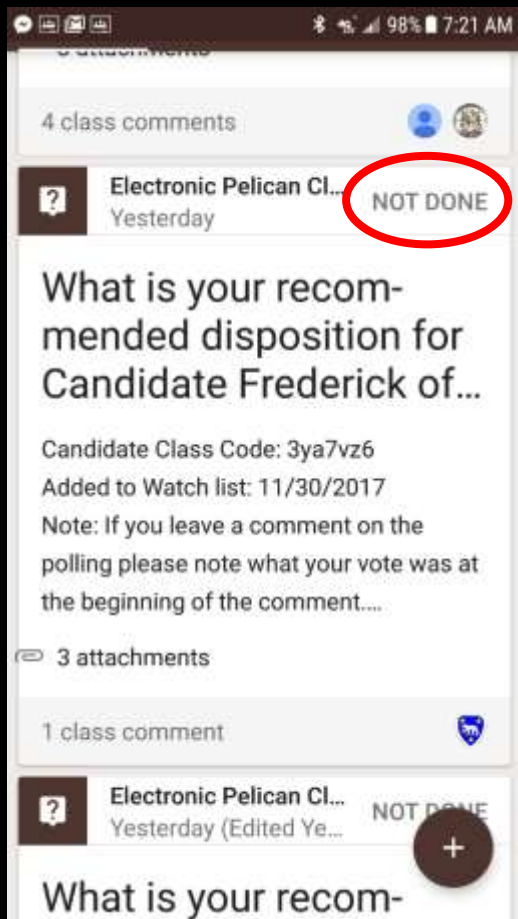

Polling takes the form of Multiple Choice Questions and will appear as assignments with due dates for the Order members. Students can indicate what they believe should happen with the candidates and reply with reasons (optional).

To have your comment appear to the entire group, enter it in the “add class comment” box. Comments can be transferred by the Electronic Clerk to Candidate Classrooms at the conclusion of the Poll if desired.



Start with the Not Done Button. Scroll down if needed. Record your answer. Make sure to click the submit button. Your assignment will show as done when recorded. To reply with a comment only to the Crown and Clerk, reply in the “Add a private comment” box in this field.

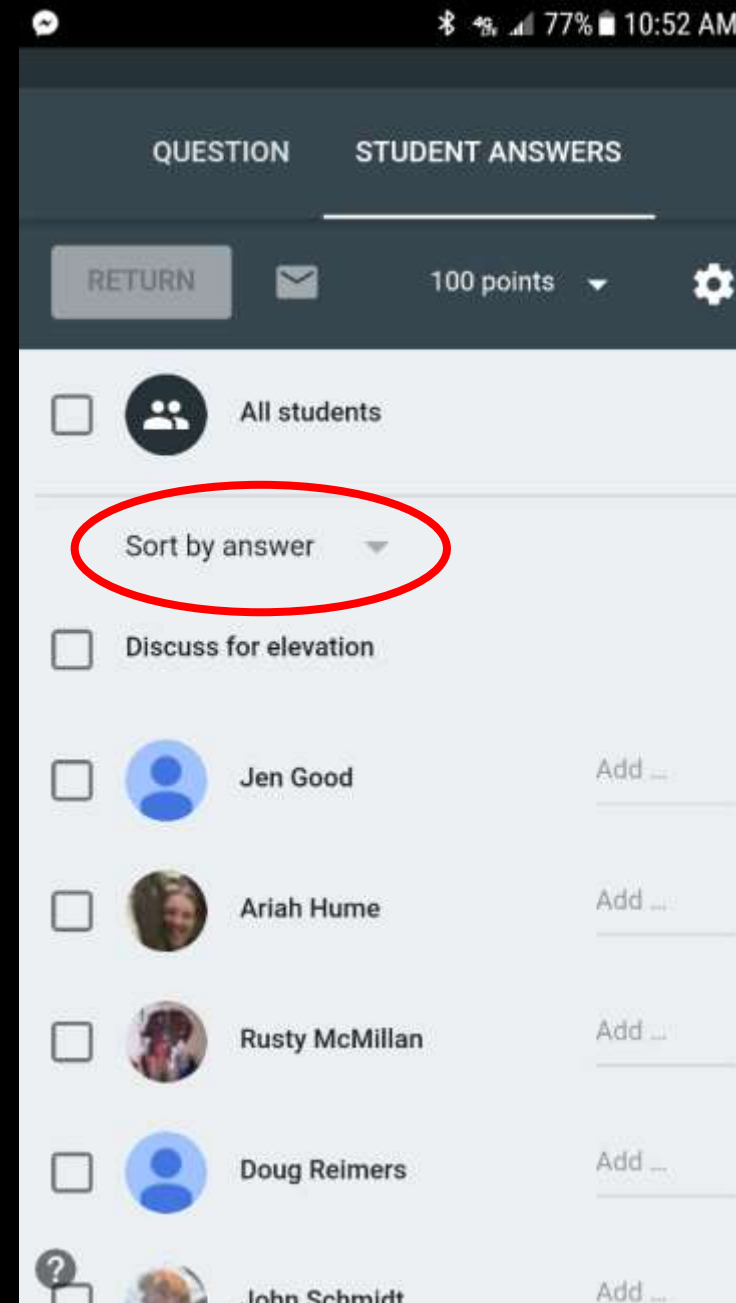

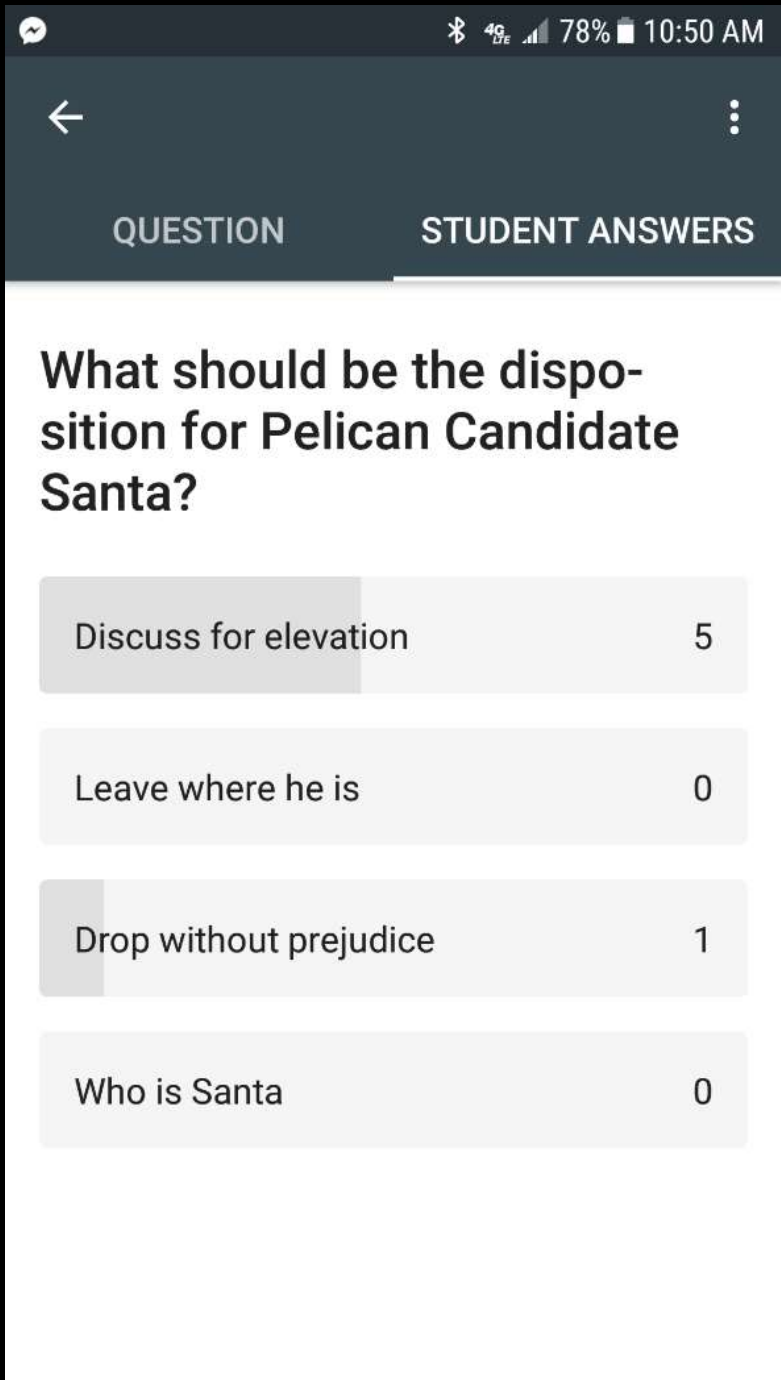
