

Candidate for Senior Heavy Marshal

The Kingdom Earl Marshal (KEM) is the only individual, besides the King and Queen, which has the authority to make a Senior Heavy Marshal in person or by proxy. The KEM may make or revoke any Senior Marshal as they see fit. This form should be filled out by the candidate or a recommending Senior Heavy Marshal. The KEM shall decide whether to make a senior marshal according, but not limited, to the following:

- Is a member of the S.C.A. Membership # _____ Membership Expiration _____
- Has been an MIC (Event - _____) or Branch Marshal (Where - _____)
- Has read the rules no less than once a year
- Has stayed active as a marshal in the last year
- Has assisted in the authorization of a fighter/is familiar with the process to authorize a fighter
- Is familiar with the process of authorizing a marshal
- Has marshaled in any capacity at a war (Event - _____)
- Has marshaled in any capacity at a Principality/Kingdom Tourney (Event - _____)
- Has an extensive previous experience as an authorized heavy fighter or marshal
- Regularly seeks out situations to teach or train marshal subjects
- Has efficiently communicated with the KEM appropriately while acting as a marshal at large
- Routinely carries a hard copy of the rules
- Demonstrates good and quick communication with the KEM
- Acts in a chivalrous manner in the execution of being a marshal
- Has answered questions from the KEM in a satisfactory manner
